finished measurements

Version 1: Approximately 18" brim circumference x 10" high

Version 2: Approximately 16" brim circumference x 10" high

materials

1 hank [BERROCO ULTRA ALPACA CHUNKY TONAL](#) (50 grs), #72302

Mallard (Version 1) or #72303

Somerset (Version 2)

16" length circular knitting needles, sizes 9 (5.5 mm) and 10 (6.00 mm)

OR SIZE TO OBTAIN GAUGE

1 set (4) double pointed knitting needles (dpns), size 10 (6.00 mm)

3 st markers (1 a different color for beg of rnd)

Cable needle

Tapestry needle

gauge

14 sts and 22 rnds = 4" in Texture st on larger needle

TO SAVE TIME, TAKE TIME TO CHECK GAUGE

TEXTURE STITCH (multiple of 4 sts + 1, worked in the round)

Rnd 1: K1, * p3, k1, rep from * to end.

Rnds 2 and 4: Knit.

Rnd 3: K1, * p1, k1, rep from * to end.



HAT – VERSION 1

With smaller circular needle, cast on 60 sts. Work in [k2, p2] rib for 3". Change to larger circular needle.

Inc Rnd 1: * M1, k2, p2, rep from * to end – 75 sts.

Next Rnd: * K11, p1, k12, p1, pm, rep from * twice more (omitting last pm because beg of rnd marker is already there).

Inc Rnd 2: * K3, M1, k5, M1, k3, p1, [k2, M1, k3, M1] twice, k2, p1, sm, rep from * twice more – 93 sts.

Establish patterns: * Work Rnd 1 of Texture Stitch, work Rnd 1 of Cable Chart, sm, rep from * twice more. Work even as established in last rnd, until you have

worked a total of 5 repeats of Cable Chart.

Shape Crown:

Note: As you decrease, when there are too few sts to fit comfortably on circular needle, change to dpns.

Dec Rnd 1: * SSK, [k1, p1] 4 times, k1, k2tog, work Rnd 1 of Cable Dec Chart, rep from * twice more – 75 sts.

Next Rnd: Knit.

Dec Rnd 2: * SSK, p1, k1, p3, k1, p1, k2tog, work Rnd 3 of Cable Dec Chart, rep from * twice more – 57 sts.

Next Rnd: Knit.

Dec Rnd 3: * SSK, [k1, p1] twice, k1, k2tog, work Rnd 5 of Cable Dec Chart, rep from * twice more – 39 sts.

Next Rnd: Knit.

Dec Rnd 5: * SSSK, p1, k3tog, p1, SSK, k2tog, p1, rep from * twice more – 21 sts.

Dec Rnd 6: * sl 1, k2tog, pss0, k2tog, SSK, rep from * twice more – 9 sts.

Break off yarn, leaving an 8" long end. Thread end into tapestry needle and draw through all sts on needles. Pull up tightly and secure. Fasten off. Weave in ends.



HAT – VERSION 2

With smaller circular needle, cast on 56 sts. Work in [k2, p2] rib for 1½". Change to larger circular needle.

Inc Rnd: M1P, k2, [M1, k1] 3 times, [k1, M1] 3 times,

ABBREVIATIONS & TERMS

Knit

beg: beginning
CC: contrasting color
cdd (centered double decrease): Slip 2 together, knit 1, pass the 2 slipped stitches over.
cn: cable needle
cont: continue
dec: decrease
dpn: double pointed needles
est: established
inc: increase
K: knit
k tbl: knit through the back loop(s)
k2tog: Knit 2 stitches together
k3tog: Knit 3 stitches together
LH: left hand
MC: main color
M1: Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from front to back, place on left hand needle, knit this stitch through the back (1 stitch increased).
M1L: Work as for M1.
M1p: Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from front to back, place on left hand needle, purl this stitch through the back (1 stitch increased).
M1pL: Work as for M1p.
M1pR: Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from back to front, place on left hand needle, purl this stitch through the front (1 stitch increased).
M1R: Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from back to front, place on left hand needle, knit this stitch through the front (1 stitch increased).
p: purl
p tbl: purl through the back loop(s)
pat(s): pattern(s)
pm: place marker
pssso: pass slip stitch over knit stitch
p2tog: purl 2 stitches together
p2sso: pass 2 slip stitches over knit stitch
p3tog: purl 3 stitches together
rem: remaining
rep: repeat
RH: right hand
rnd(s): round(s)
RS: right side
sl: slip
sm: slip marker

SSK: Slip 2 stitches knitwise, insert point of left hand needle through fronts of these 2 stitches and knit 2 together.

SSP: Slip 2 stitches knitwise, transfer these 2 stitches back to left hand needle, purl 2 together through the back loops.

st(s): stitch(es)

TBL: through back loop(s)

tog: together

WS: wrong side

wyib: with yarn in back

wyif: with yarn in front

yo: yarn over

end on WS: end having just completed a Wrong Side row.

end on RS: end having just completed a Right Side row

STOCKINETTE ST (St st): Knit 1 row, purl 1 row alternately when working on straight needles. The knit side is the right side of work. Knit EVERY round when working in the round on a circular needle.

Reverse St st (Rev St st): Purl 1 row, knit 1 row alternately when working on straight needles. The purl side is the right side of the work. Purl EVERY round when working in the round on a circular needle.

GARTER ST: Knit EVERY row when working on straight needles. Knit 1 round, purl 1 round when working on a circular needle.

Crochet

ch: chain

dc: double crochet

hdc: half double crochet

sc: single crochet

sl st: slip stitch

sp: space

tr: treble
